UCAS Applications

1

Application

For undergraduate full-time courses, apply through ucas.com. Once your application has been received by the University, you'll receive login details to MyTSD, the University's applicant portal, which will become the student portal following enrolment.

Interview / Assessment

Your application will be considered by the relevant Admissions Tutor. Decision turnaround times vary depending on whether or not you are required to attend an interview, audition or to submit a portfolio as part of the admissions process.

Response to an offer

To respond to an offer for a UCAS course, log into your UCAS Hub account and follow the instructions given by UCAS.

Decision / Offer

If your application is successful, you will receive an offer of a place through UCAS.

Confirmation

If you have received a conditional offer of a place, your offer will be made unconditional once the University has received notification that you have met the terms of the offer.

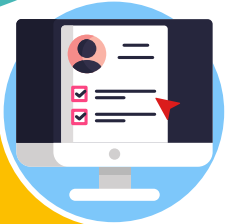
Pre-enrolment Tasks
