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**Pre-Requisite: Standard of Intensive Latin II, or Latin A Level (at grade C and above) or equivalent.**

### **AIM(S)**

- To translate accurately the Latin language of a poetic text at an advance level.
- To develop further skills of literary analysis and interpretation, and to gain an understanding of the text's historical, cultural and literary context as reflected both in the text studied and relevant modern scholarship.

### **LEARNING OUTCOMES**

Upon the successful completion of this module, the student should be able to demonstrate:

- Advanced knowledge of Latin grammar and syntax through translation of the text studied and unseen translation work.
- Sound knowledge of the text studied and modern scholarship on this text in literary and linguistic analysis.

### **INDICATIVE CONTENT**

Students will study a work of Latin literature in the original language. The module will focus on verse (e.g. a Seneca tragedy, a selection from Virgil's Aeneid). A different text is chosen each semester and year. All set text prescription will normally be translated in class; distance learners will submit set sections of translation and commentary for tutor comments. Detailed language work will be combined with the development of skills of literary criticism and attention to the historical context of the works studied. In order to help students translate with greater skill and accuracy the module contains an unseen translation component. Students in this module are taught in the same group as students in Further Advanced Latin: Verse and Higher Advanced Latin: Verse.

The study time for the module is divided as follows:
