- Plus Level 5 NVQ Diploma in Construction Management
- Level 4 CIOB in Site Management

Quantity Surveying

- Higher National Diploma (HND) in Quantity Surveying
- Plus Level 5 NVQ Diploma in Construction Management
- Level 4 CIOB in Site Management

Target Audiences: Highly motivated individuals seeking a career, or enhanced career, in the construction industry.

Entry requirements: Consideration will be given to all applicants employed in the sector with employer approval.

Apprenticeship eligibility: To complete the programme you must be employed in a technical, supervisory or similar role within the construction industry.

Duration: Target completion three years.

Cost: The apprenticeship programme is fully funded and employers may be eligible for CITB support grants.

Attendance: One extended university/college day per week.

Providers (locations): Various venues throughout Wales.

Additional outcome: CSCS Black Card (on application and completion of the CIOB Level 4 Certificate) and an appropriate level of CIOB membership.

Progression: Honours Degree in a construction discipline or potentially a Degree Apprenticeship.
