WILL YOU BE A FRESHER

OR A FRAUD VICTIM?

Don't risk your future! Educate yourself on frauds and scams which students are vulnerable to.

MONEY MULES



A money mule lets their bank account be used for transferring and laundering money, keeping a small cut. If caught, they risk a criminal record.

ACCOMMODATION FRAUD



Accommodation scams or frauds are when someone tricks you in to sending money to rent a room, which doesn't exist or belongs to someone else.

PHISHING SCAMS



Phishing scams are becoming more difficult to spot. Tricking people into sharing sensitive data or downloading malware, making them vulnerable to fraud.

CONSUMER FRAUD



Buying concert tickets online? Booking a last-minute holiday? Seen an ad online that seems too good to be true? It most probably is! No matter what you are buying - you could fall victim of fraud.

Don't let **bike theft** be a lesson you need to be taught this academic year! Take extra precaution to **double lock your bikes** and **park any vehicles in safe areas**.
